30 MINUTE LOOP (0.5 miles)

FIR TRAIL

Beginning at the Pavilion, across from the Visitor Center, this short loop is fairly level. It skirts the Spruce Collection, passes through patches of salal (a common shrub in Pacific Northwest forests), and loops around the Pine Collection.

1 HOUR LOOP (0.9 miles)

SPRUCE/WILDWOOD/REDWOOD TRAILS

If you are seeking the deep forest, this is a rewarding route. It begins at the Pavilion, across from the Visitor Center. The route passes through spruce trees from all over the world and meanders by the Wedding Meadow. It then plunges through the towering redwoods. The Redwood Deck provides a bird's-eye view before you continue to the trail below.

2 HOUR LOOP (1.25 miles)

OVERLOOK/WILDWOOD/HAWTHORN/MAPLE/WILDWOOD/HOLLY TRAILS

This loop is a great "sample." The route offers deciduous trees and conifers, open meadows and varying elevations. It is a great tour of the southeast quadrants of the Arboretum. A side trip to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial is well worth it. As you pass through the collections, watch for interpretive exhibits that provide insight into what makes these tree assemblages unique.
